LOOKING FOR Dogs with MUE

Does Cyclosporine or Leflunomide work better?

Study Details:

- Patients are randomized to be treated with either leflunomide or cyclosporine.
- All dogs will receive prednisone.
- Owner pay for costs until diagnosis.
- Owner will pay for additional rechecks (after 6 weeks), medication, and blood work.
- Rechecks are scheduled for 6 weeks,
 12 weeks, 6 months, 12 months,
 18 months, and 24 months after diagnosis.
- Phone calls are done between rechecks to get updates and taper medication.
