



LOOKING FOR Cats with FIP

Studying response to FIP treatment options

The Study

We are comparing treatment response in cats diagnosed with FIP.

One group will receive in hospital intravenous remdesivir. The other group will receive GS-441524 by either subcutaneous or oral administration.

Who Qualifies

We are currently enrolling cats diagnosed with FIP that are being treated either in hospital or at home.

Why Participate

The study pays for an FIP PCR and an FIP FA test to be run on fluid or aspirates from an affected organ or tissue (\$300-400 value).

It will help us learn if there is a difference in response to different treatment options available.
